Dr. Korrin Scott Ford is an associate professor in the Division of Cardiothoracic Anesthesiology at Emory University School of Medicine and practices cardiac and thoracic anesthesia exclusively at Emory University Hospital and EUH-Midtown. She completed her undergraduate degree in neuroscience at Vanderbilt University, medical studies at University of Texas Medical School, anesthesia residency at University of Virginia Medical Center, and fellowship in cardiothoracic anesthesiology at Emory University School of Medicine.

In addition to being the anesthesia director of adult congenital heart disease and the director of simulation for the Department of Anesthesiology, she was selected for the inaugural cohort of the Emory University School of Medicine Women's Leadership Course. Dr. Ford has served the GSA in many capacities, including as ASA Delegate, chair of the Nominating Committee, chair of the Bylaws Committee, member of the Program and Education Committee, member of the Anesthesia Care Team Committee, member of the Women in Anesthesia Committee, and the current President-Elect.
